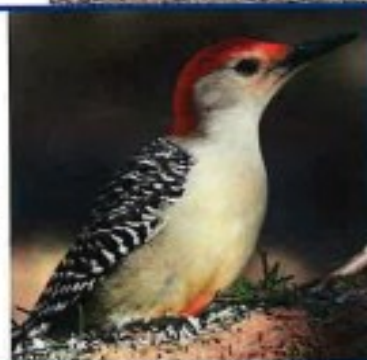
Learn all about North America's largest aquatic mammal, the American beaver. **Registration required.**
