“Senior Farmer’s Market Nutrition Program.”

Eligible applicants must be as of July 1, 2015:

- 60 years old or older
- Low-income (below 185% of Federal Poverty Level)

185% of the Federal Poverty Level is equal to:

\$21,775 annual income or \$1, 815 monthly for 1 person; or

\$29,471 annual income or \$2,456 monthly for 2 people.

Applicants must have proof of identity and residency via: Driver’s License, Utility Bill or Birth Certificate. A current Income Tax Return, Social Security Statement, Food Stamp/SNAP verification, Medicaid Card - (not Medicare Card) will be accepted as proof of income. Sometimes applicants report only Social Security but be advised that your pension also counts as part of your annual income.

Applicants must have proof of identity and residency via: Driver’s License, Utility Bill or Birth Certificate.
