

## **2021 Fall Leaf & Brush Collection Schedule**

### **Please Read Carefully as** **The Collection Methods Have Changed.**

Effective Monday, October 25th Public Works  
Will Begin Leaf Collection  
Throughout The Town.

### **The Township of Ewing Will No Longer Pick Up Loose Leaves.**

**As Per Updated Regulations From The NJDEP**

**Ewing Township Ordinance § 319 Article V: Leaves, Brush and Yard Waste Has Been Updated  
To Remain In Compliance With NJDEP**

**Stormwater Rules and Regulations And Is As Follows:**

**All Leaves and Other Yard Debris (Including Grass)**

**Must Be Placed In Biodegradable PAPER Bags.**

**Containers May Be Used As An Alternative.**

**The Leaf Collection Schedule Will Be The Day After Your Garbage Day.**

Ewing Department of Public Works will Strive To Keep Up With Said Schedule.

However, If You Notice That Your Garbage Day Has Come And Gone, Please Be  
Patient... We Currently Have An Employee Shortage And There Are Situations When Equipment Will  
Break Down Which May Set Us Back From Keeping With The Leaf/ Brush Pick Up Schedule.

If This Happens Please Remain Calm And Do Not Panic Thinking That We Forgot Your  
House / Street Etc. We Will Service All Homes.

In Addition, Brush/ Tree Parts Must not be longer than 4 FT. Long and a Maximum Di-  
ameter Of 6 Inches. You May Containerize Your Brush. You May Also Use Rope/ Twine  
For Brush.

The Leaf Bags, Containers and or Bundles Should Not Exceed 50 Lbs.
