**Cost: \$65.00**

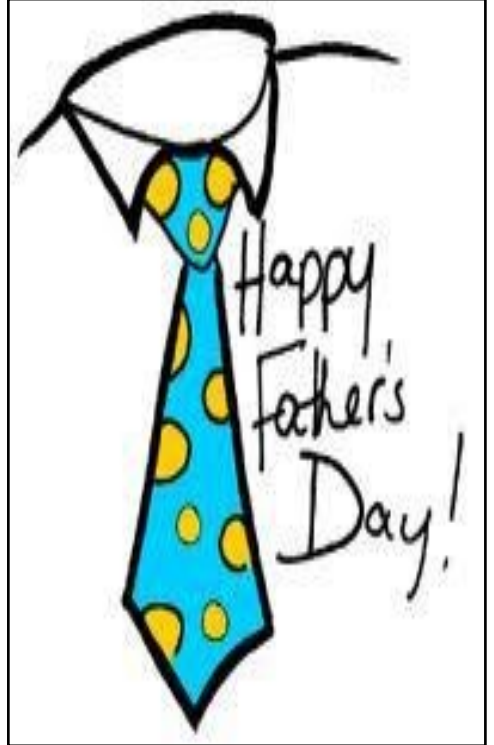
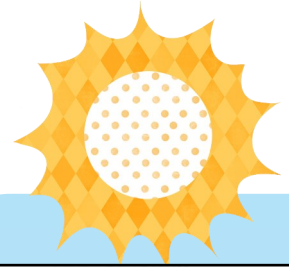
