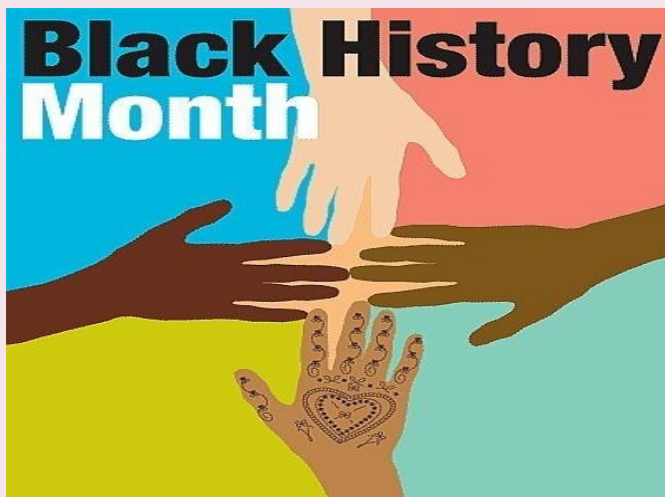

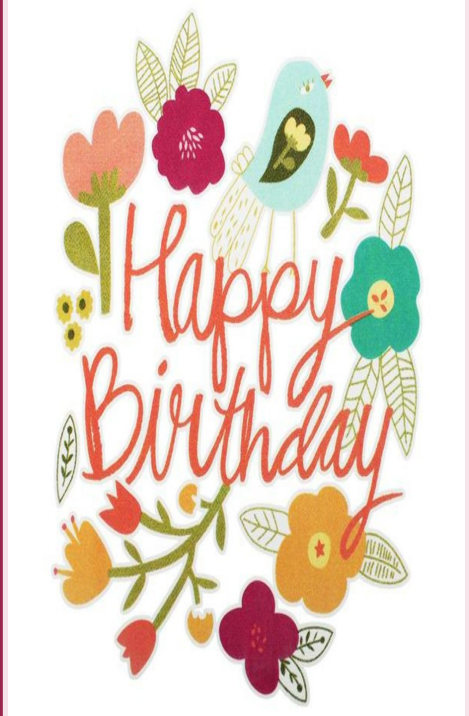
HOLLOWBROOK SENIORS NEWS 2023
